

LEAVE OVER FESTIVE PERIOD

The following arrangements will be in place over the upcoming festive period:

- The MDDA will operate on skeleton staff from 18 to 22 December 2017 and 3 to 5 January 2018.
- MDDA Offices will be closed from 27 December 2017 to 2 January 2018.
- The office will be fully operational from 8 January 2018.

Leave taken from 8 December 2017 to 2 January 2018 will be deducted from the staff member's annual leave and the normal leave application must be followed via the MDDA ESS platform, before the leave is taken.

Staff members who have insufficient annual leave credits may borrow up to 4 days annual leave credits, that would have been accumulated by the end of the current leave cycle ending 31 March 2018.

No staff member is allowed to carry more than 6 days annual leave credits into the new leave cycle that commences on 1 April 2018. Therefore, staff members are encouraged to utilise their annual leave credits by 31 March 2018.
